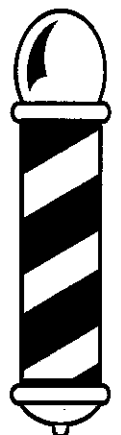
Hair & Incidentals policy

Girls:

- Hair should be kept neat, well groomed and off the face
- No changing the color of one's hair
- Headbands must be on the hair not the forehead (Neutral colors ONLY). Not wider than 1 inch.
- NO colored contact lenses
- NO MAKE-UP OF ANY KIND
- NO nail polish or excessive or flavored/colored lip gloss
- NO chains, dangling earrings, chokers, buttons, and pins
- Only religious medals/necklaces
- NO more than one earring in each year
- NO facial piercings or tattoos
- Acceptable to wear wrist watches, one bracelet, and only one ring
- NO jewelry on PE day

Boys:

- Hair should not reach the top of shirt collar
- Bangs should not obscure vision or reach below eyebrows
- Extreme hair-styles are not allowed
- NO #0, #1 or #2 hair cuts. (Scalp must not be visible)
- NO changing the color of one's hair
- NO spiked hair or other fads
- NO colored contact lenses
- May not wear earrings, facial piercings or tattoos
- Only religious medals/necklaces
- Acceptable to wear wrist watches, one bracelet
